Solo Performer - Can be Singing guitarist, Instrumental guitar or instrumental ukulele

Duo - Guitar/vocals + keyboard or cajon

Trio - Guitar/vocals + cajon + bass or keyboard

4-Piece - Guitar/vocals + drums + bass + keyboard

5-Piece or more - Varies, request a quote

Ceremony - This is a flat rate which covers music during guest arrival, ceremony and recessional. Trio and band lineups are not usually necessary for the ceremony.

Cocktail Hour - Covers 1 hour of music during the cocktail hour. Solo, duo and trio are the most common lineups for this part of the wedding.

Dinner - If you want live music for dinner, you should also plan to use the same lineup for the reception. 4-Piece band is the most common for dinner. Dinner is a 1 hour minimum payment.

Reception - 4-Piece band is the most common lineup for the reception. Reception is a 1 hour minimum payment.

Mileage and Lodging

For events more than 50 miles away from Nashua, NH there will be a mileage charge of \$1/mile for each performer. For events more than 100 miles away a hotel is sometimes requested.

Meals

If you are having live music for the dinner and/or reception, it is customary to provide a meal for each performer. Performers are usually unable to leave the site to eat due to setups/breakdowns.
